To whom it may concern:

The colostrum used to produce Immune-Tree colostrum products has been extensively evaluated by Minnesota Valley Testing Laboratories, a premier dairy testing facility, and in the laboratories at the College of Veterinary Medicine, Cornell University. Review of the derived data and comparison of it with data reported in the scientific literature clearly substantiates that a) the colostrum is from the first milking following birth of the calf; and b) the colostrum was collected within six hours following birth of the calf.
